

YEAR 10 SUBJECT SELECTION PROCESS

TERM 1

YEAR 11 PATHWAYS ASSEMBLY

- Initial assembly where students are given general information about the Course Selection process and the VET and ATAR Pathways are explained.
- There is another assembly in Term 2 with more detail.

WK 10, TERM 2

CAREERS AFTERNOON

- Students attend a Careers Afternoon during period 5 & 6
- Various TAFE and university course providers present with course information and presentations for students

WK 10, TERM 2

SUBJECT SELECTION INFORMATION EVENING

- The evening includes new information about Years 11 & 12, details about VET pathways, the ATAR pathway and the requirements for WACE.
- Families have the opportunity to speak directly with the Heads of Learning Area and see displays from TAFE and university course providers.

WK 10, TERM 2

ONLINE BOOKING INVITATION

- An email will be sent to families from the Dean of Education with a booking link for Course Counselling
- Links to resources included: Year 11 Curriculum Handbook, Year 11 VISN Handbook, TISC University Admission, SCSA Year 10 Information Handbook and Year 11 Handbook.

END OF TERM 2

BOOK COURSE COUNSELLING INTERVIEW

- Families will have a window to book their time slot of an interview on the Course Counselling Day, which will happen in Term 3
- Families book a time through Edval when the booking session opens

END OF TERM 2

COURSE COUNSELLING INTERVIEW PREPARATION SHEET

- Families are sent a letter about the Course Counselling Day with a link to the Course Selection Interview Preparation sheet to fill out and bring to the day.

END OF TERM 2

SEMESTER 1 REPORTS

- Families receive Semester 1 Results, which will inform the options available to the student.

TERM 2 BREAK

SUBJECT RECOMMENDATIONS

- In the weeks following the end of Semester 1, the Head of Year 10 will make Subject Recommendations available to families on SEQTA Engage.
- Subject Recommendations will inform choices as certain Years 11 & 12 courses have pre-requisites.

TERM 2 BREAK

FAMILY DISCUSSIONS

- Students and their parents/ carers discuss their futures, the options available and start to narrow down a Pathway.

TERM 3

COURSE COUNSELLING DAY

- Students and their families attend the Course Counselling Day, where they have an interview with a key member of staff who assists with narrowing down choices and answers any final questions.
- Selections are finalised during the interview.
